- ❖ No materials, patterns or tools are included in the program fee unless noted
- ❖ There is a 10% discount on materials, patterns and tools if purchased in our shop;

- ❖ The shop is trying to be a profitable business (not easy for a yarn shop); therefore we ask that when you are knitting in the shop, at least **MOST** of your yarn has been purchased here.

Winter 2019 Classes

Beginning Knitting Tues/Thurs 5-7 pm

Learn the basic technical skills (Knit, Purl, Increasing & Decreasing), how to read a pattern, and how to select the right yarn and needles for your project.

\$75.00 sessions or 4 sessions, or \$25 for 1 Thursday nights from 5-7 pm, with Darrel & Becky.

Tuesday Knitting with Kelly 2pm-3pm

In February & March Kelly will focus on Blocking Basics. Bring a finished piece of knitting (yarn must have been purchased at Apples to Oranges) and get hands-on blocking instruction.

\$75.00 sessions or 4 sessions, or \$25 for 1.

Thursday Knitting with Becky 2 pm-3 pm starting Feb.7

From cast on to blocking, learn to make a hat in four sessions. Learn different techniques of casting on, different stitches, increasing and decreasing.

\$75.00 sessions or 4 sessions, or \$25 for 1

Very beginning Knitting/ Crochet Class Feb.16 and March 16.

Free one Saturday (with the purchase of materials) every month. *This is a "Bare-Bones" session which covers Casting On, Knit, Purl and Binding Off only. For a more in-depth class or if you have a project you wish to learn, please consider our 1-on-1 lessons, Tuesday Night Beginning Knitting or Knitting 9-1-1 for more in-depth instruction. Needle Felting with Pamela

The 2nd Thursday of every month



from 1:30-3:30pm. In this class Pamela will teach you the basic process of needle felting while you create your own beautiful, 3-dimensional work of art.

Class Fees:

\$25/new student (includes materials).

\$15/Returning Students (includes fiber only).

Frida Felted Bag with Celia (Intermediate)

Sat Mar 2nd and 16th Noon-3pm and April 6th from Noon-3pm

Class fee: \$80 for 3 Sessions. Celia will teach you how to knit and felt a fabulous large bag (perfect size for a knitting bag)! Minimum 3 Students (Maximum: 6)

Skills Needed: Must know how to knit & purl in the round

Materials Needed: US Size 10.5 or 11 24" circular needles and 6 skeins of Cascade 220 yarn in various colors.

*Materials are not included in the class fee (unless otherwise noted).

Hairpin Lace Cowl with Carol. Saturday, 2/23/19 from 1-3pm

Learn the fundamentals of creating hairpin lace strips and joining lace units as you create a beautiful cowl.



Skills Needed: Must know how to knit and purl.

Materials Needed: **Hairpin Lace Loom, Yarn, Waste Yarn** in a contrasting color,

Crochet Hook (size appropriate to project yarn), **Tapestry Needle, and Locking Stitch Markers.**

*Class Fees:

\$30/ student (Does NOT include materials).

Kids Knit

(\$40.00 for 3 sessions or \$15 for 1 session)

Thursday afternoons from 4-5pm Beginning Knitting for Kids (grades K-12). Children learn basic knitting skills while creating something wonderful with their own two hands! This is a great "mid-week wind-down" for your children after a busy day at school. Minimum of 3 students required.

Needle Felted Bunny class with Teresa

Cavender 3/9/19 and 3/16/19 from 11am-1pm Teresa has been teaching felting for 15 years and she will be here to share her adorable Bunny project with us!

This is an intermediate class. Previous Felting Experience is Required. (See our Needle Felting with Pamela class for Beginning Felting)



Class Fee: \$75 for both Sessions (Includes Felting Mat & Needles) or \$45 for the 1st Session (includes felting mat & needles) and \$35 for the 2nd Session (does not include materials). Class Supply List available at sign-up.
